Planned spending for 2017-18

Funding has increased to £16,000 +£10 per pupil for 2017-18

Priorities for 2017-18 are:

1. Membership of the Slough Schools Sports Network (approx. £7,000)
2. Establishment of Daily Mile as a fundamental part of the school day; installation of an all-weather track on the school field (£6,000)
3. Provision of sports clubs for a) vulnerable pupils and b) G&T pupils (£4,500)
4. Participation in competitions and tournaments, travel to tournaments, any additional coaching, team kits (£1,500)
5. Active promotion of lunchtime sports and games for all pupils, purchase of equipment, provision of sports day medals (£900)
6. Promotion of 'Let's Get Going' initiative to promote healthy lifestyle (£300)

Total proposed spend = £20,200
