Friday Letter from Mrs Maynard

Dear Parents and Carers,

School Opening

Again, this week there has been much information about the reopening of schools and the cohorts of children who may be able to return. The safety of pupils, staff and parents is the primary consideration in the decision making process about when St Ethelbert's school will open again.

I am working closely with other local primary schools, the local authority, the teaching unions and our fellow Catholic Trust schools to examine the DfE guidance and establish exactly what safe provision we could make for your children, my staff, and you as parents.

This is a complicated process, and will take time to get right. St Ethelbert's Catholic Primary School will not be opening on the 1st June, and at present, I am not able to give a confirmed opening date. Please continue to keep your children safe at home until you have been directly contacted by us to offer you a place. Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 parents have been contacted regarding the need for places. As per DfE guidance, we will not be able to offer places to siblings in other year groups.

The school only has capacity for a certain number of pupils if safe distancing guidelines are to be followed, again we will work out the best solution for the children and staff and inform parents when it is possible for their child to attend school. It may be that part-time places have to be offered to meet the safety guidance.

I would like to thank parents again for your patience as school staff work to find solutions to a very difficult situation that keep everyone in the St Ethelbert's community as safe as possible.

Joe Richardson, the Strategic Executive Lead of our Trust has composed a letter to parents that will be sent alongside this newsletter, and I have added a video to the website to explain the school's position.

School remains closed to all other than children of keyworkers who are unable to keep their children at home.

School will be closed for all pupils during half term week, Monday 25th May to Friday 29th May, and on Monday 1st June for a staff INSET day

St Ethelbert's Catholic Primary School and Nursery has a commitment to safeguarding, and the welfare and wellbeing of children.
