Remote learning provision Advent 2020

In the event of a year group having to self-isolate as a result of a positive Covid-19 test in the year group, teaching and learning will have to move to an online provision of live teaching for pupils in Year 2 and above.

Individual pupils who have to self-isolate for a period of time will have access to works packs and/or remote learning managed by year group staff.

This will be delivered via Microsoft Teams or Seesaw, depending on the age of the pupils. All pupils from Year 2 upwards have been issued with email addresses and passwords they can use to access Teams. Teachers will set up class meetings for pupils to access from home.

Set up two meetings, one for morning session, one for afternoon. Assembly slides will be saved on staff drive on Monday, Wednesday and Friday for teachers to deliver to their class at the start of these days
