Question	Pupil Responses
If you felt unsafe or unhappy at school, what would you do?	<i>Tell the teacher Write in the worry box Talk to my friends Tell other school staff</i>
If there was an emergency at school, what would you do?	<i>Go outside as quick as I could Avoid the danger. Hide under the table for Lockdown Tell a teacher If it is a fire alarm, go outside If you see a fire, press the fire alarm and tell a teacher</i>
How do you keep safe when using the computer?	<i>Don't friend people who you don't know Ask an adult if you are unsure of something Do what is right- Don't give out your personal information</i>
What would you do if you were worried about a test you were about to take?	<i>Tell your teacher you need help so they can explain the ideas again and ask for extra homework Give it your best try Tell your parents you have a test and are worried. They can help you to recap questions at home with you Do something fun to take your mind off the test</i>
If a friend is worried about an issue outside of school, what would you do?	<i>Ask them what is going on and try to help them or tell a grown up Comfort them and tell the teacher Sit down and talk to them about their issue Tell them to call Childline Tell their mum Tell your parents you are worried about them</i>

If you are in a disagreement, what is the best way to solve it?	<i>Talk it out</i> <i>Vote for what to play</i> <i>Reflect on what has happened</i> <i>Do something else with them</i> <i>Try to make them understand your point of view and why you feel that way</i> <i>Take some time for yourself to calm down</i>
Do you understand our school behaviour system? Do all staff follow the system?	<i>Yes- all agreed</i> <i>Yes- all agreed</i>
How do you know you are doing the right things at school?	<i>Staff facial expressions</i> <i>Peg moving up chart</i> <i>Getting Dojos</i> <i>Praise from teacher</i> <i>Certificates given out</i> <i>Positive minutes system</i>
