<b>Sports equipment</b>	<i>£313.14</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pupils have good quality equipment to work with</li> <li>• Items purchased include: Basketballs, Footballs and lunchtime equipment</li> </ul>
<b>Active movement license</b>	<i>£600</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Imbedding active lifestyle choices into school routines</li> <li>• Promoting benefits of moving and oral health</li> <li>• Active ambassador scheme</li> <li>• Engagment with families regarding good lifestyle choices</li> </ul>

## **Planned spending for 2020-21**

Funding will be £19,500 with £5,553.86 carried over. Total **25,053.86**

### **Priorities for 20/21 are:**

1. Membership of the Slough Schools Sports Network (£5,295)
2. Provision of sports clubs (38 weeks) for a) vulnerable pupils and b) G&T pupils (£8000)
3. Participation in competitions and tournaments, travel to tournaments, any additional coaching, team kits (£2,500)
4. Staff CPD (£500)
5. Sport leadership training for children (£250)
6. Active promotion of lunchtime sports and games for all pupils, purchase of equipment including medals, provision of sports day (£5000)

**Total proposed spend = £21,545**
