## **Planned spending for 2021-2022**

Funding will be £19,500 with £19,000 carried over. Total **£38,500**

### **Priorities for 21/22 are:**

1. Membership of the Slough Schools Sports Network (£6000)
2. Provision of sports clubs (38 weeks) for a) vulnerable pupils and b) G&T pupils (£8000)
3. Participation in competitions and tournaments, travel to tournaments, any additional coaching, team kits (£4,000)
4. Staff CPD (£2000)
5. Sport leadership training for children (£250)
6. New sport experiences for children (£4000)
7. Active promotion of lunchtime sports and games for all pupils, purchase of equipment including medals, provision of sports day (£5000)

**Total proposed spend = £29,250**
