### Planned spending for 2021-2022

Funding will be £19,500 with £19,000 carried over. Total £38,500

#### Priorities for 21/22 are:

- 1. Membership of the Slough Schools Sports Network (£6000)
- 2. Provision of sports clubs (38 weeks) for a) vulnerable pupils and b) G&T pupils (£8000)
- 3. Participation in competitions and tournaments, travel to tournaments, any additional coaching, team kits (£4,000)
- 4. Staff CPD (£2000)
- 5. Sport leadership training for children (£250)
- 6. New sport experiences for children (£4000)
- 7. Active promotion of lunchtime sports and games for all pupils, purchase of equipment including medals, provision of sports day (£5000)

Total proposed spend = £29,250
