Planned spending for 2020-21

Funding will be £19,500

Priorities for 20/21 are:

- 1. Membership of the Slough Schools Sports Network (£5,295)
- 2. Provision of sports clubs (38 weeks) for a) vulnerable pupils and b) G&T pupils (£8000)
- 3. Participation in competitions and tournaments, travel to tournaments, any additional coaching, team kits (£2,500)
- 4. Staff CPD (£500)
- 5. Sport leadership training for children (£250)
- 6. Active promotion of lunchtime sports and games for all pupils, purchase of equipment including medals, provision of sports day (£3455)
- 7. Additional playground and field equipment gym machines, playground markings (£5000)

Total proposed spend = £19,500
